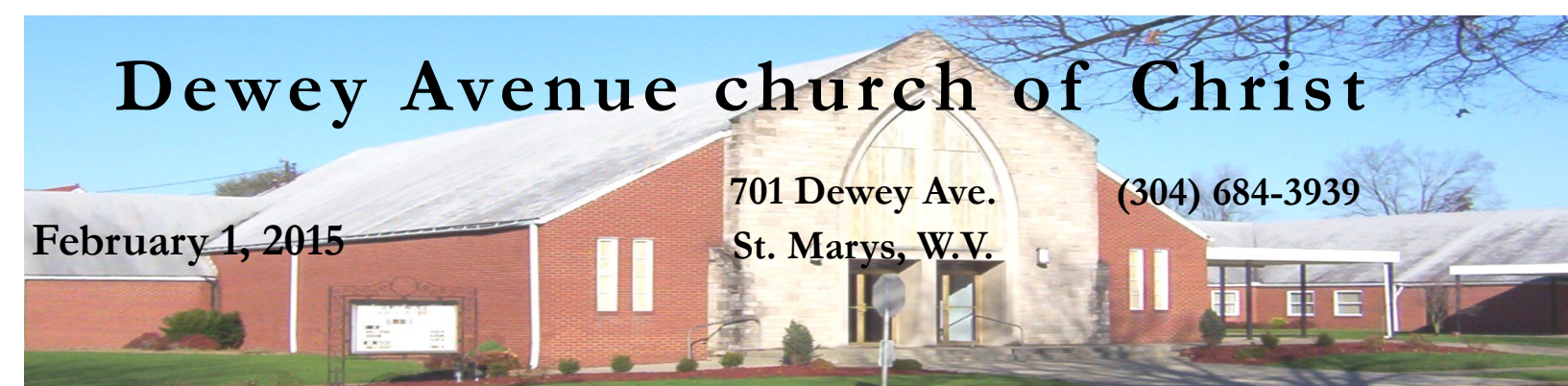

**A Tribute to Ruby Bennett**

Last Wednesday was the funeral of a beloved sister in Christ, Ruby Bennett. *Psalm 90:10* says, "The years of our life are seventy, or even by reason of strength eighty; yet their span is but toil and trouble; they are soon gone, and we fly away." Not everyone lives to age 70. Even fewer to 80. Ruby was blessed to live a life of 93 years on this earth influencing others. I personally was not able to get to know Ruby very much. Yet hearing others speak of her, I learned that she left behind a great Christian example. Her unwavering commitment in assembling with the Saints, her service for many years in running the clothing room and many other things she did for the church and others. Her example and memories will live in those who knew her best.

As a Christian, I am confident that this is not the last time we'll see Ruby. The Apostle Paul wrote to the church at Thessalonica, "But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. (14) For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep. (15) For this we declare to you by a word from the Lord, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. (16) For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. (17) Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. (18) Therefore encourage one another with these words" (1 *Thessalonians 4:13-18*).

There is comfort, excitement and hope that the day will come where all of God's children will be reunited, forever to be with one another, but more importantly to be in the presence of God in His eternal home. Ruby will be missed. As Christians, let us live in such a way to have the confidence of eternal life when this temporary life comes to an end.

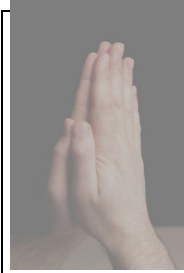
