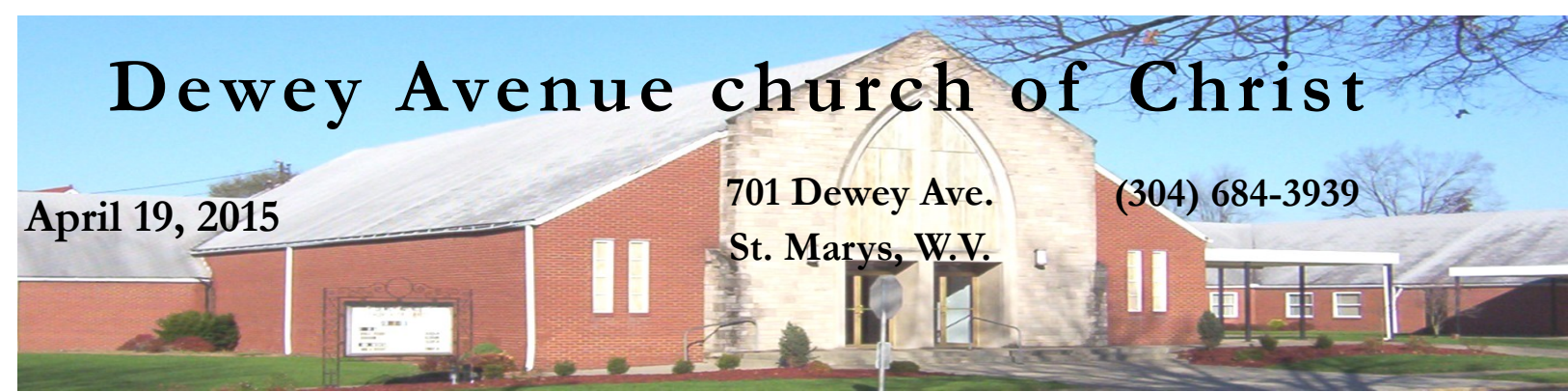

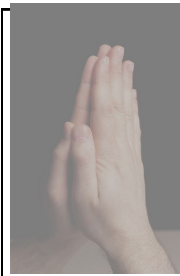
Birthday/Anniversary Dinner: April 26 after Sunday evening service. Everyone is welcome!
