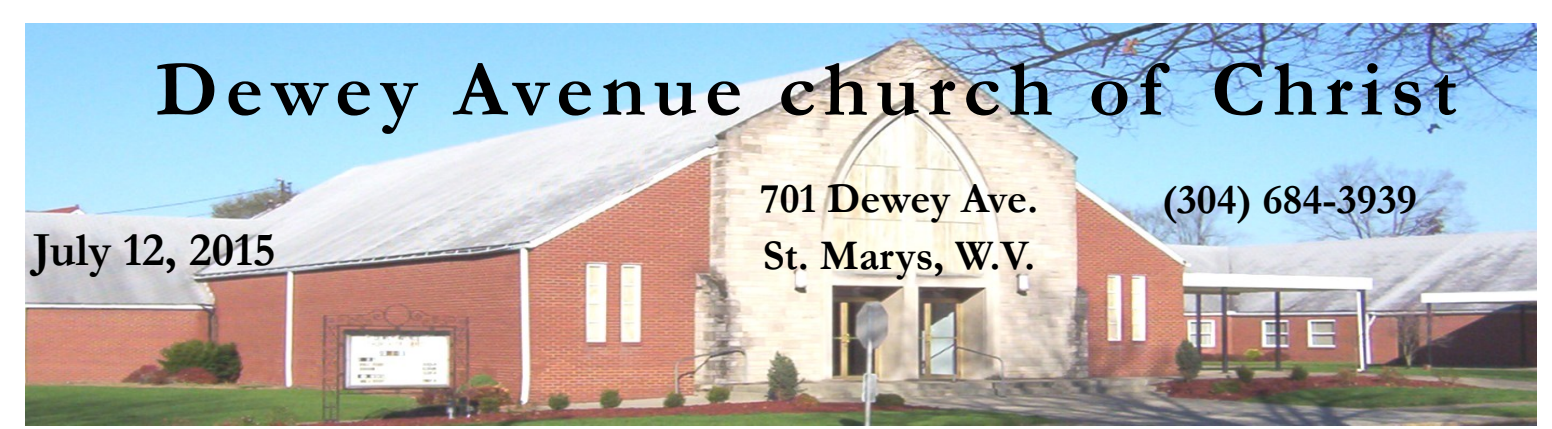

**Go and Sin No More**

I heard someone say the other day that Jesus would approve of homosexual marriage. Their reasoning was that Jesus did not condemn the woman caught in adultery in John 8 to be stoned. It is true that Jesus did not condemn her but it is out of context to think that Jesus approved of what she had done. It is also out of context to think that the woman would be able to continue in the adulterous relationship that she was living in. Under the Law of Moses, one caught in adultery was to be stoned. This woman being caught in adultery was brought to Jesus and asked what He thought. Jesus stated that those without sin could cast the first stone. No one in any situation can cast a stone being without sin except Jesus Christ. Romans 3:23 teaches us that all have sinned. None of us have lived a life that is without transgression toward God. Was Jesus saying to this woman that her sin was acceptable? NO. It is important to note that after Jesus said neither do I condemn thee, he also said, "Go and sin no more." 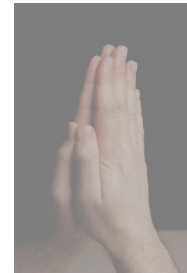
