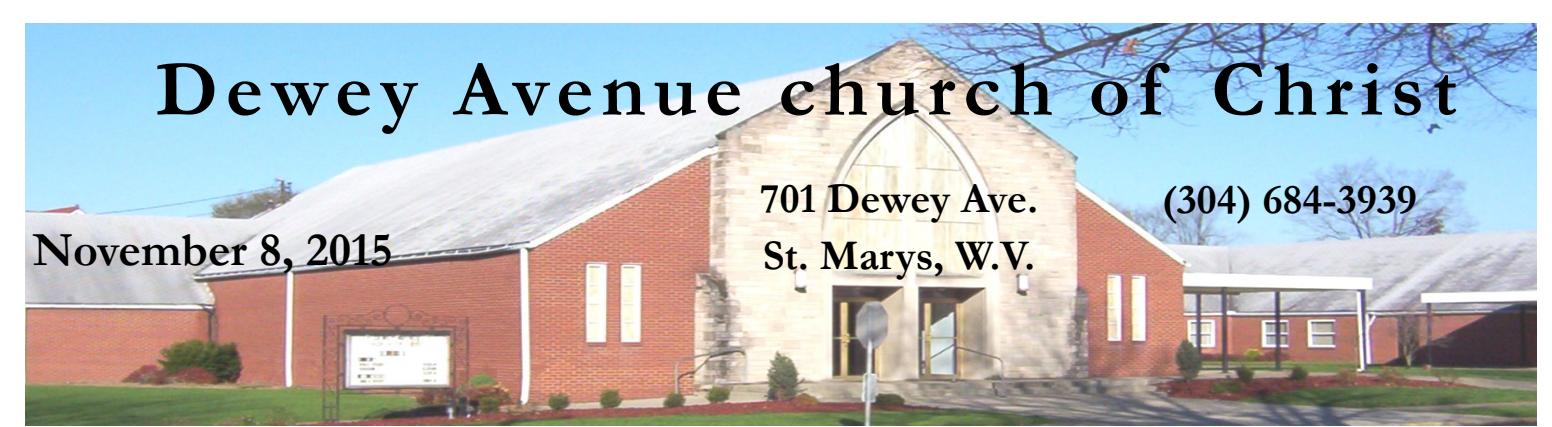

ADMIRATION, INFLUENCE AND IMITATION:

Admiration often leads to imitation. Depending on the person, this can be good or bad. The young child that admires his father will often have the same interest of his father, will demonstrate the same vocabulary and mannerisms as his father and even dress just like his father. The star athlete, actor or singer who is admired by many youth can have an influence on some leading them to imitate him/her in how to dress, what food, cars, people or beliefs to like or dislike, etc.

John Baillie in a written prayer gives some reasons why we should admire Christ and how we should imitate Him:

*"I give you thanks for this Your greatest gift:
 For my Lord's days upon the earth:
 For the record of His deeds of love:
 For the words He spoke for my guidance and help:
 For His obedience unto death:
 For His triumph over death:
 For the Presence of His Spirit within me now:*

Grant that the remembrance of the blessed Life that once was lived out on this common earth under these ordinary skies may remain with me in all the tasks and duties of this day. Let me remember –

*His eagerness, not to be ministered unto, to but minister:
 His sympathy with suffering of every kind:
 His bravery in the face of His own suffering:
 His meekness of bearing, so that, when reviled, He reviled not again:
 His steadiness of purpose in keeping to His appointed task:
 His simplicity:
 His self-discipline:
 His serenity of spirit:
 His complete reliance upon You, His Father in Heaven.*

And in each of these ways give me grace to follow in His footsteps." (Calvin Miller, THE BOOK OF JESUS, p. 50-51)

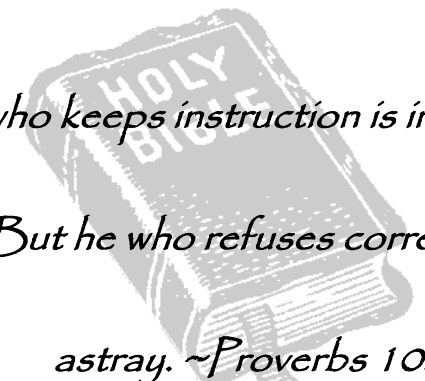
November 12th: CareHaven Sing at 7:15pm.
