

CHRISTIANITY MIXED WITH PAGANISM

A preacher friend of mine told me a story about a Christian lady who called and asked him if he had any black chickens. When asked why, she said the blood from a black chicken can cure her friends' case of shingles. Even though this Christian lady would denounce paganism and witchcraft, my friend told me this belief is a form of witchcraft. A little bit of research on the internet reveals it also may have originated from the pagan beliefs of some American Indians (see www.lumbee.web.unc.edu/online-exhibits-2/healing-practices/).

When Paul and Silas arrived on the island of Cyprus to preach the gospel, they encountered a man named Elymus, who the Bible identifies as a "magician, Jewish false prophet" (Acts 13:7). In other words, he integrated pagan beliefs with Old Testament Judaism, essentially forming his own religion, which made him a person of influence with some government officials (Acts 13:7). Considering the gospel message from Paul and Silas was a threat to his influence, he sought to undermine Paul's preaching in which Paul sharply rebuked him and miraculously struck him blind (Acts 13:10-12).

Mixing God's Word with false religions is nothing new and seems to be on the rise. A study conducted by the pew research center in 2017, revealed that a good number of people today who self-identify as Christian also hold to some "new age" beliefs too. For instance, 37% believed that spiritual energy can be located in physical things like mountains or trees; 40% believed in psychics, 29% believed in reincarnation, and 26% believed in astrology.

I wish I could say that mixing pagan beliefs with God's Word is like mixing oil with water, in that one can clearly see the separation. However, because pagan beliefs mixed with the Scriptures can go unnoticed, it's more like mixing water with a poison. As Christians, we must strive to have a trained eye to spot error from truth (Hebrews 5:14). Preachers on TV like Joel Olsteen may not teach error on everything, but the overall promising message of health, wealth and fame is no different than what the devil tempted Jesus with in Matthew 4:1-10.

When it comes to matters of science and medicine, there is nothing wrong with certain medicines, exercises, and diets, as long as they do not incorporate any form of paganism or violate Scripture. When it comes to beliefs regarding an after-life, right and wrong, our faith and meaning to life, God's Word is the final authority (2 Timothy 3:16-17; John 12:47-48).


